### **National Call-In Day TOMORROW for Health Reform**

Dear APSE Members,

Congress has come a long way over the past few months towards passing health care reform legislation. Despite concerns that Congress has stalled on its promise of comprehensive health care reform, we must not give up!

Tomorrow, *January 26th, 2010*, is a national call-in day to urge Members of Congress to continue their efforts at passing health reform. Call your Representative and Senators and ask that they complete health care reform. Tell them how truly important it is that we reform our health care system and include the CLASS Act and Medicaid and home- and community-based services.

#### **How to Call:**

Dial the Capitol switchboard at (202-224-3121) and ask for the offices of your Representative and Senators.

Visit [www.house.gov](http://www.house.gov) and [www.senate.gov](http://www.senate.gov) to find your Members of Congress.

#### **What to Say:**

Explain that NOW is the time to act and pass comprehensive health care reform legislation. Remind them that the CLASS Act, Medicaid and home- and community-based services must be included in the final package!

Be sure to talk to members of BOTH parties - all Members of Congress must hear from voters that health reform is important.

Even with the most recent developments over the past few days, we must not be discouraged - change is still possible!
