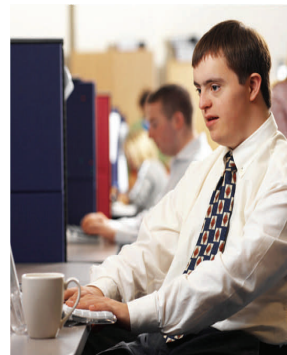
APSE Mission
